

Anton Sidler

Age 74, passed peacefully at home surrounded by his closest family and loved ones after a courageous 9 year battle with cancer.

Anton was born and raised in Switzerland, moved to Canada as a young man where he met his beloved wife, Gerda, who was from Holland. Together they lived and worked in the Bahamas and Florida before moving to Wilmington, DE in 1976. After 16 years of marriage, their daughter, Jessica, was born in 1982.

Anton worked at the Hotel DuPont, Franklin Plaza Hotel, Shop Rite, and Super G as an award winning baker and pastry chef. He often referred to himself as the "sweetest man in town."
